





District 6400 Rotary Foundation Committee Structure, Quorum, and Motions

- 1. The ex-Officio members of the District Rotary Foundation Committee are the:
 - a. District Rotary Foundation Committee Chair,
 - b. District Governor, District Governor-Elect and District Governor-Nominee.
- 2. The members selected by the District Rotary Foundation Committee Chair and the District Governor are:
 - a. Two members of the Financial Assessment Committee, one of whom will be designated as the chair.
 - b. Volunteers / Alumni Officer.
 - c. Peace Fellowship Officer.
 - d. Fundraising Chair with committee members:
 - i. Endowment Fund Officer.
 - ii. Annual Programs Officer.
 - iii. Paul Harris Society Officer.
 - e. Polio Chair.
 - f. Stewardship Chair.
 - g. Grants Overview Chair with committee members:
 - i. District Grants Officer.
 - ii. Global Grants Officer with committee members.
 - 1. Global Scholars Officer.
 - 2. Vocational Training Team Officer.
- 3. The sub-committee of voting members includes the
 - a. District Governor,
 - b. District Governor-Elect,
 - c. District Rotary Foundation Committee Chair,
 - d. Fundraising Chair,
 - e. Polio Chair,
 - f. Stewardship Chair, and the
 - g. Grants Overview Chair.

The District Governor-Nominee is invited to all meetings of the sub-committee as a non-voting guest.

- 4. A quorum of the sub-committee of voting members is 4 and a simple majority of the members present is required to pass a motion. That is, if 4 or 5 members are present, 3 yes votes are required to pass a motion, if 6 or 7 members are present, 4 yes votes are required to pass a motion.
- 5. That if a vote is taken outside of a meeting, e.g., by email, all members are deemed to be present and 4 yes votes are required to pass a motion.
