Maeven Sipes attended a recent Club meeting to heap praise on our generosity, and also to warn us of lean days ahead due to Congressional budget cuts in the Supplemental Nutrition Benefits Program (SNAP), which was already stressed by increasing demand for nutritional assistance

"We're seeing increases in need year over year," Sipes said. "(Our) pantry is serving about a thousand families every week. We've provided more than three million pounds of food this fiscal year. Last year we served 1,300 Naperville residents and over 200 residents have volunteered a total of 6,500 hours of their time." Added Sipes, "we can always use more volunteers."
