Many are aware of the Louisville Slugger Sports Complex (known as the LSSC) and how many youth and college baseball / softball teams which come to the area yearly. But cricket, lacrosse and volleyball are also part of the games that people play in Peoria in the huge sports complex. In the fifty acres of the LSSC, there are ten playing fields as well as the 125-thousand square foot dome for indoor / bad weather sports.

Also new for this year, the complex will host all four classes of the IHSA softball state finals – beating out East Peoria as well as the Chicago Bandits Stadium in Rosemont, the Family Sports Complex of Rantoul and Southern Illinois University. In addition to sporting events, you can experience this amazing venue in a whole new way this summer. The Tailgate N' Tallboys, popular country music festival, is being held at the Louisville Slugger Sports Complex on Thursday, June 3rd & Friday, June 4th, 2021.
