# **Rivian Electric Vehicles** Laura Ewan, Community Relations Coordinator



Rivian Automotive spokeswoman Laura Ewan tells Peoria Rotarians that the company's new all-electric pickup truck and van will be priced around \$75,000. Rivian's plant in Normal, Illinois is expected to start producing the vehicles this summer, possibly as early as June. Covid-19 forced Rivian to halt there-tooling of the former Mitsubishi plant for a while.







There are currently 1,600 employees at the plant in Normal, and Ewan says there will be more hiring in the future. Rivian got a big boost when Amazon ordered 100,000 custom-designed electric delivery vehicles. Amazon, Ford, and Cox Automotive have invested 2.8 billion dollars in the company, giving it a lead in developing all-electric vehicles. Pickup trucks and vans account for the majority

of personal use vehicles sold in the U.S., and those are the vehicles Rivian is manufacturing first. According to published reports, Rivian has already copyrighted designations for sedans as well.


Tom McIntyre finds "THE PRINCESS BRIDE" to be lovely fun and that it is an adult fairytale, and his favorite character is Andre the Giant.
