Peoria's Downtown Development

Michael Freilinger, head of Peoria's Downtown Development Corporation, says the key to rebuilding a thriving downtown is relocating people there. He said that in July, an additional 120 expected living spaces would be opening. Freilinger told Downtown Rotarians on Friday that he expects to see many more projects coming to the district. Add to those are the additional office personnel that OSF is sending into the downtown area, and Freilinger expects big things. Parking, he says, will become a problem and looks to see city leaders address that.



As an example of entrepreneurship in action, Freilinger introduced Tia Bailey, a recent thirty-something transplant to Peoria from Seattle. Bailey has opened "Loftie", a short-term rental property in the Warehouse District opposite Thyme restaurant. The property at 725 SW Washington has 36 studio and one bedroom apartments and includes a gift shop, conference room and lounge. Bailey says it's perfect for people coming to town for concerts, museums' the
