Illinois 16th District Congressman Darin LaHood Update from Washington DC

16TH District Congressman Darin LaHood gave Peoria Rotarians an update on Friday

in a speech that touched on foreign affairs, the national debt,
George Santos, and the ongoing conflict in Ukraine. LaHood's district
has changed radically by redistricting, and he says that now he
represents about 15-percent of Peoria County. Most of Peoria
County is now in the 17th District, represented by Democrat
Eric Sorensen, who succeeded Cheri Bustos.

LaHood said he was happy with a bill which provides that lawmakers get 72 hours before they vote on a bill, giving them time to understand how much it costs. He said it was a reaction to the Leadership of both parties handing Congress a one-point-eight trillion-dollar spending bill with less than 24 hours to digest it. LaHood also said a major act by Congress was creating a select committee on China. The Congressman said "China has a plan to replace us. And they're working on it every day." LaHood said he hoped to be a part of that select committee. In addition, he applauded a bill passed this week which stopped selling oil from the Strategic Petroleum Reserve to China.

LaHood announced money will be going to expand the locks on the Illinois River at Creve Coeur from 600 to 1200 feet long. This will provide easier, faster transport of long grain barges down the Illinois River to the Mississippi. Finally, the Peoria Congressman said George Santos, just elected to Congress

representing Queens, New York, should resign his house seat after Santos was shown to be a liar about his education, work experience, mother's death, imaginary holdings in Brazil and his arrest in that country. But LaHood says there is nothing that can force Santos to resign.
