Jerry Kolb - Building the Peoria Music Scene One Concert at a Time

Peorian Jerry Kolb talked about the importance of live music to Peoria Rotarians last Friday. Kolb created the popular WTVP-TV music program "State and Water", when he worked at the public TV station. Now retired, he's pushing the concept and experience of live music for Central Illinois, promoting bands and locations which promote the concert experience.

Comparing listening to live music to seeing and hearing tunes on an I-Phone, Kolb figures the I-Phone listener is getting little of the dynamics of the music and little of the fun. Kolb spoke of his promoting concerts at the Blue Ridge Community Farm, a working

farm near Chillicothe for people with disabilities.
