## Youth Exchange Program



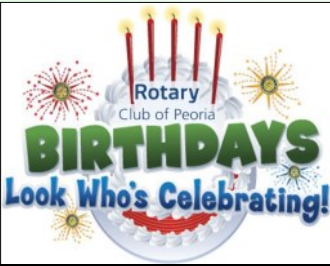
### Be a Youth Exchange Host Family!
