Porch Pantry Peoria

Kelli Martin, the co-founder with her husband of 'Porch Pantry" in Peoria spoke to Rotarians on

Friday. The Martin's efforts to provide food in their neighborhood began in March of 2020. They simply put food on their porch at 1122 North Ellis Street for anyone to take. The Martins thought their efforts would only last a few months. It's still going on, despite some setbacks along the

way. According to Kelli Martin: "21,000 people



in Peoria suffer from hunger on a daily basis, including 7,000 children."

That means, Kelli said, that 30 to 50 people take food or goods from her pantry daily. She told Rotarians, "We don't require ID, which lets us serve homeless people that might be turned away from other centers".

"Porch Panty" is now a 501 3C not-for-profit operation, handing out not only



food for people but animals as well, along with clothing and other items which might be in short supply. Donors can give directly to relief efforts led by Rotary members.

Contributions will be accepted until 31 December 2023.

Any contributions that haven't been

spent by 30 June 2024 will be transferred to the general Disaster Response Fund, to be made available for disasters worldwide.
