## Jack Darin, Chapter Director - Sierra Club of IL

The Illinois General Assembly approved the Climate and Equitable Jobs Act (CEJA) in September of last year. Proponents call it the most sweeping legislation passed in over a decade.

The Sierra Club's Jack Darin told Peoria Rotarians that under the bill, Illinois has some of the most significant clean energy and decarbonization commitments in the nation. A major component



of the bill requires Illinois to be reliant on 100% renewable energy by 2050.



To do that, replacing coal-fired power plants, means spending billions of dollars to create thousands of jobs for communities formerly dependent on salaries from coal power plants which will be shut down. There's not enough space here to summarize the one-thousand-page bill.

Long time Springfield Observer Rich Miller summed it up this way in an article published in The Chicago Sun-Times.




