Julie Eliathamby, Founder of Peoria Grown, spoke to Peoria Rotarians about her volunteer organization and how that nonprofit's grown to address food insecurity by upgrading



access to wellness programs and fresh food. Eliathamby, who works as Operations Manager for the Better Banks locally was tapped in 2018 by Senator Chuck Weaver to look into "food deserts" which had appeared with the closing of two Peoria supermarkets.



Since then, her organization has flourished, and was able to generate funds to hire their first part-time employee, a dietician. Currently, Peoria Grown offers cheap produce at three "Market 309" locations weekly in Peoria.

One of those perhaps surprisingly is on the Bradley University Campus.

Peoria Grown has also placed fruit stands at local community centers to provide healthy snacks at no cost. Wellness classes also have been offered, with fresh free ingredients provided to participants as well.
