Jim Baldwin and Laura Evancho - Wheels O' Time Museum




The leaders of Peoria's Wheels O' Time Museum came to downtown Rotary on Friday, letting members know about the changes that have

been taking place at what's been called "Peoria's Attic". Jim Baldwin and Laura Evancho assumed leadership roles at the museum in 2019, and since then,

attendance and memberships have steadily increased, financial contributions have grown, and a new exhibit building was constructed.

The Wheels O' Time Museum became a nonprofit organization in 2017. Its exhibitions include indoor / outdoor displays, antique and collector cars, trains, fire engines, airplanes, bicycles, farm & Caterpillar equipment, tools,





people unfamiliar with the Museum don't realize it, there are four buildings in the Museum complex. The latest built houses a WW2 airplane, Caterpillar tractors and a Lego train set. Moving into the 21st century now means the Museum takes credit cards and some long-time displays --like the train cars - are being upgraded. The Wheels O' Time Museum is located between Peoria and Dunlap at 1710 W Woodside Dr. in Dunlap, just off Knoxville Avenue. The museum will be open May 1st - October 31st, Wednesday through Sunday - Noon to 5:00pm.

Midwest Food Bank is looking for volunteers to help label and/or package bulk food items so they can be readled for distribution to our food pantries.


