Peoria Public Library Director Randall Yelverton and assistant Director Veronica DeFazio told Rotarians that Peoria's Main Library is now a



"FamilySearch affiliate library" — one of only a few hundred in the U.S. FamilySearch, known as the world's largest family tree, has billions of records, many of them accessible online and for free.

But the Peoria Public Library now has access to more records as an affiliate library. Access is available in

person only at the Main Library's Local History and Genealogy Department.

Yelverton and DeFazio also pointed out the library system also has many movies and tv shows on-line through the website Kanopy. If you have a Peoria Public Library card, you can get access to Kaznopy's free movies, children's programs and documentaries through the Internet.

The Peoria Public Library is a sponsor of an on-line talk by Mary Roach, dubbed "America's funniest science writer" by The Washington Post. The event "The Weird and Wonderful World With Mary Roach" is being held online on Wednesday, March 1, 2023 at 7pm.
