Mayor Rita Ali - Reports on the City of Peoria



Peoria Mayor Rita Ali told Peoria Rotarians about her life and her hopes for Peoria on Friday. Peoria's first woman and person of color chief executive moved to the River City at the age of six. She attended the now-closed Lee Elementary, Roosevelt and Manual schools on Peoria's near-north side.

With the aid of money from the Romeo Garret scholarship program, Rita Ali went to Bradley University. It took eight years to get a BA, as she was a single parent working at the time. Eventually, Rita Ali would obtain two master's degrees and a PhD.

Mayor Ali told Rotarians to check out the Economic Innovation Group's (EGI) website eig.org if they were interested in learning more about their community. The website features an interactive map to locate distressed neighborhoods according to their zip code. She pointed out how one distressed neighborhood can -without help—drag down its neighbors.

The mayor is optimistic about the proposed Peoria-to-Chicago passenger train line. Already, communities along the path of the former Rock Island Rocket have signed on supporting the proposed passenger service. Mayor Ali says the feasibility study will wrap up in April, but a search for a downtown depot is already underway.
