Dr. Meenakshy Aiyer of UICOMP (University of Illinois College of Medicine Peoria) was Rotary's Friday speaker. She is the eighth regional dean since 1970 and holds the titles of Head and Professor of Clinical Health Sciences Education and Pathology and in addition,

Dr. Aiyer is a Clinical Professor in the Department of Medicine.

Medicine is a big business in Peoria. City leaders are proud of the fact that sixteen percent of Greater Peoria's workforce is employed at hospitals, clinics, specialty centers, and educational institutions, resulting in double the national average.

Currently, the number one and three employers in the Peoria area are hospitals: OSF St. Francis, and Carle-Methodist and Carle -Proctor. The new OSF Cancer Care Center could attract new staff and new patients to the area. Add to that, the number of the independent physicians, and all the nurses in training at five local

schools (Bradley, ICC, Methodist, OSF and Knox College) and you can certainly

speculate medicine could be a large part of Peoria's future.

But, Dr. Aiyer says, UICOMP programs aren't just helping Peoria. She pointed to the RSVP program at the med-school, which has students during their training spend time in rural communities, because as a result they are more likely to practice in rural communities.


## Rotary Readers Upcoming Fieldtrip

This year's Sterling Merit Awards Banquet will be held on May 7, 2024, at the Peoria Civic Center Ballroom. The Keynote Speaker will be Nikki Romain - Co-founder for Artists ReEnvisioning Tomorrow (ART, Inc)

The annual banquet will host students and their parents from the following area schools: Brimfield, Dunlap, East Peoria, Elmwood, Farmington, Illini Bluffs, Illinois Valley, Limestone, Manual, Peoria Notre Dame, Peoria Heights, Peoria, Princeville, Quest Academy and Richwoods High Schools.

We anticipate 650 plus in attendance. We honor the top eight percent of high school graduates who have attained the highest standing in their classes. The Sterling Merit Awards Banquet gives public recognition to students who have excelled academically during their high school years.

Last year 170 students qualified for the award and 153 attended the banquet, accompanied administrators from each school and by parents and/or other family members. This is a very meaningful event for students and their families, and our club has enthusiastically co-sponsored the event for over 50 years.

Students attend the banquet free of charge. Family members are asked to pay \$20.00 which is well below cost, and this year includes free parking. For the past several years, we have offered opportunities for sponsorship to partially defray the costs of the event and to keep charges within a reasonable range for our families.

We have developed six sponsorship levels which are described below. We are asking club members to strongly consider becoming a sponsor at whatever level you see fit. ## **FOUNDATION MINUTE: DISTRICT GRANTS**



The District Grants Program will provide funding for one-time-only community-service projects that involve the active, personal participation of Rotarians. The projects should serve as a means of enhancing the community and/or improving lives of the less fortunate where Rotary clubs are present.

Funding for these grants come from donations to the Annual Fund - SHARE made three years ago. The funds we received are typically only around \$2,000, but our Club could choose to grant more from our local Endowment.

What District Grants Support You can use district grants to fund a variety of district and club projects and activities, including: Humanitarian projects, including disaster recovery efforts | Local projects | Youth programs | \* Projects should correspond with one of Rotary International's 7 Areas of Focus

Past District Grants we have received funds for include computers at Trewyn, helping fund the new Girl Scout troop at Trewyn, Sterling Middle School outdoor learning space, and Sterling Middle School supplies.

District Grants are usually due mid-August. If you have an idea for one, please reach out to the Foundation Committee Chair! The organization receiving the grant must be a 501(c)3.
