Gary Jacob & Emily Jacob-Rudesill

Foster-Jacob, Inc. is one of the oldest electrical contracting companies in central Illinois, and it's still owned by the original founder's family.

Two members of that family spoke to Rotarians on



Friday: Gary Jacob and daughter Emily, who is now company President. It all began with John George (J.G.) Jacob working as an electrician for Best Electric in Peoria in the 1920's and through the Great Depression. In 1933, he

decided to start his own business, Jacob Radio and Electric, in Morton. The company's name was changed to J.G. Jacob and Sons in the late 1930's when his sons, Ray, Joe, and Ken joined the company.

By the mid 1950's, the Jacob family assumed control of Foster Electric and Foster-Jacob was formed. Ray's eldest son, Gary, took control of the company in the 1990's, After learning the company ropes at an early age, visiting job sites with his grandfather and working in the shop.

Gary joined the apprenticeship program in 1967 at age 17 and in 2003 earned his M.B.A at Bradley University. Gary was the third generation of his family to own the company.

In 2009, Gary's daughter, Emily graduated from college and joined the business. The next year she was accepted into the JATC apprenticeship program, where she worked for five years. After graduating from the apprenticeship, she became majority owner and President in the Fall of 2015 and the fourth generation of her family to run the Peoria company.
