University of Illinois System

Peoria Rotarians heard from two leaders from the University of Illinois on Friday.

Dr. Nicholas P. Jones is the Vice President for Academic

Affairs at the University of Illinois System, second-in-command to the president.

Dr. Meenakshy Aiyer is the Regional Dean at the

University of Illinois College of Medicine at Peoria.





Their talks confirmed that medicine is one of the strongest economic drivers in the Peoria region.

OSF Medical Center and the Carle HealthCare
Hospital (formerly Methodist Medical Center) are

together the largest employers in the region.

With four local nursing colleges and the U of I Med School added, its clear medicine is a strong component of the local economy.

Dr. Jones points to the University of Illinois itself as a major economic driver for the state - by educating as many students as it does. In fact, he says, 52% of all students attending public universities are at a University of Illinois campus.
