### Local Realtor Developments

### Katie Kim , The Kim Group



Peoria Developer Katie Kim returned to the Peoria Rotary Club on Friday for an update on her continuing efforts to change what was once an old IDOT office complex on Knoxville Avenue.

It is now called the Keller Station buildings, which the Peoria Park District assumed control of, and which Kim and the park district are now partners in the development. Kim says that keeps the Park District receiving money from the once abandoned offices and garages.

There are several offices inside the Keller Station buildings, and Kim says there are on-going plans for more. There are also plans for another round of Farmer's Markets at the site off Knoxville's parking lot.

There's also plans for a micro-brewery at the Keller Station property which would open this summer, part of the third phase of the development of the old IDOT property.



In addition, the Kim Group is also pursuing the development of condos in Peoria Heights along Samuel Street. Kim said that a survey had shown that there was a lack of that type of housing in the mix in the heights.


