Ty Livingston & Eric Miller Tri-County Regional Planning Commission

The East Peoria Director of Planning and Development, Ty Livingston, told Peoria Rotarians on Friday about the value of hiking and bicycling trails. Livingston and Eric Miller of the Tri-County Regional Planning Commission were at Rotary to discuss planning for increasing the trail system on

the Tazwell side of the Illinois River. That would require the extension of trails and paths from the Bob Michel Bridge to the McCluggage Bridge.

The McCluggage bridge's new span under construction now includes a bike

path, something never considered when the bridge was first built. Planners face the problems of several different property owners along the Illinois River on



the Tazewell side, and the fact that footbridges over marshy areas could cost millions of dollars. But Miller and Livingston said that you must have a plan in place before you can

even start looking for funding for projects like these. On the positive side, they say there's ample



proof that trails and bike paths add measurably to the value of the neighborhoods they go through.

Rotary Service Project for Luz's Make-A-Wish

Luz Elena, age 11 of Peoria had her wish for a Barbie Dreamhouse style playhouse granted by Make-A-Wish Illinois thanks to generous community support. Luz was diagnosed in 2017 with a lifethreatening seizure disorder. Luz wished for a playhouse and swing

set in her backyard to have a safe space to play and be free of her anxieties and exhaustion that her frequent seizures and hospitalizations often bring. She asked for the playhouse to have a Barbie Dream House theme full of pinks and purples, a play kitchen, swing set and a

dog bed for her beloved chihuahua Canello. Make-A-Wish Illinois staff and volunteers worked to grant Luz's playset wish that was

presented at a reveal party at the family' home on Saturday. The

Peoria area community has been very supportive of the wish and a number of individuals, community groups and businesses have helped to make a special playset area. Volunteers Bobby Taylor, Maria Ramos

and Janet Glavin have worked to plan Luz's wish over the past year. Illinois State University students enrolled in a senior level interior design class created several visuals of the interiors based on the Barbie Dream house for Luz to choose from.

Mid-Illinois Companies and the Mid-American Carpenters Regional Council apprentice program helped to build and finish the playhouse over the winter and early Spring. Volunteers from the Rotary Club of Peoria and other Make-A-Wish volunteers helped to finish the interior of the playhouse by assembling and installing the

furniture and décor including flowers & mulch. Community supporters generously provided flowers (Kelly Seed) & party day food items (Palarte Mexican Ice Cream, Hy-Vee & Party City).
