- * Successfully completed 13 goals, and will be awarded the Rotary Citation in recognition of its good work for the year!
 - * Supported the Annual Fund of the Rotary Foundation, with total contributions of \$15,560!
- Club's support of End Polio Now contributions this year are at \$3,960, which is just shy of what was raised last year!
- * The Endowment and Foundation Committee voted to approve \$26,201 to fund the Neighborhood House Outdoor Learning Space project!
 - * Recognition was given to retiring Board Member Dr. Bill Albers and Immediate Past President (IPP) - Brad Stegall (2020-2021).

Youth Exchange Program ~ Host Families Needed










The Rotary Club of Peoria International Youth Exchange Program is still looking for two additional host families for a four-month period for each family. We have secured our first host family but need two more.
