Hooked On Fishing Park is a private, not-for-profit organization that provides fishing opportunities for the community. Their passion is helping children, senior citizens, and special needs groups to appreciate the joys of fishing. They primarily work with school groups, scouts, park districts, community groups, churches,

special needs groups, nursing homes, and other organizations that provide services for kids, senior citizens, or disabled individuals.

Hooked On Fishing Park provides their guests with all of the equipment and bait needed to go fishing. Beyond the basics, they enjoy teaching fish biology, knot tying, fishing ethics, fishing techniques and good fishing sportsmanship. All of the fishing is "catch and release".

They are happy to work with teachers, scout masters and group leaders to custom design instructional programs that meet their specific educational objectives. The enthusiastic volunteers are able to provide much one-on-one



help, guidance, and instruction to novice anglers.

Adam grew up in Tremont but has lived in the Champaign area for the last 10 years. He and his family have recently moved back to the Peoria area for his wife, Lindsey to join the morning show on a local radio station and for Adam to join the team at Hooked On Fishing Park!

Adam and Lindsey have two girls, Ruby and Remy. Adam is a longtime outdoorsman and has made hunting and fishing a lifestyle and over the years has developed a love for duck decoy carving, duck call turning, fly tying & fly and conventional fishing rod building. Adam's entire career has been spent in the nonprofit world and community involvement. His love for fishing is almost as strong as his love for people.
