Rotary International District 6460 Governor Bill Durall's Official Club Visit

Rotary District 6460 President Bill Durall visited the Peoria club on Friday. A retired Air Force officer, Bill first served almost ten years as an enlisted man working as a Russian voice processing technician. He earned his Air Force commission in 1982 and spent the next 27 years in a variety of leadership positions in the communications-computer arena. He retired as a Colonel in 2009 and joined the Rotary Club of Pike County.

Talking about a post-Covid world, Governor Bill stressed that changes are coming to Rotary, as they are too many organizations and businesses. "The new definition of insanity', '' he said, "is doing the same thing we've always done and expecting the same result".

Bill Durall says he has four priorities: Increasing impact, Expanding Rotary's reach, Enhanced Participant engagement, and Increased ability to adapt. And, he said, "Imagine Rotary", the slogan chosen by Jennifer Jones, Rotary's first woman president, gives wide scope to think about what Rotary can do and be.

Governor Bill Durall also spoke of the need for District 6460 clubs to get behind a project now underway near Chongwe, Zambia. A Rotary team working there has been introducing more efficient methods for growing corn. A planter is needed, however. That's something not

originally considered when Rotary took on the project. The Peoria Rotary Club presented Bill Durall with a \$500 check toward the cost of the \$15,000 planter.
