# East Peoria Mayor John Kahl



East Peoria Mayor John Kahl told Peoria Rotarians and their Cast Peoria guests that his city council had to make a lot of difficult decisions due to Covid's effect on the economy and lifestyle of Central IL. In 2020, East Peoria's Council cut budget items by 15 % in anticipation of reduced sales tax and gambling revenues. The most recent budget restores some items, getting the city closer to pre-Covid days.

Meanwhile, Mayor Kahl says a delayed 45 million dollar mixed-use development is still on the horizon. The project has been reported to include over 200 market-rate apartments and condos, as well as 10,000 square feet of retail space. It would be located on vacant property near the Holiday Inn in the Levee District. Kahl says a groundbreaking is now planned for spring of 2022.




Mayor Kahl also said he and a few other folks were aware ahead of time that East Peoria's Festival of Lights had won ABC-TV's Great Christmas Light Fight in 2020. Now Kahl says he's working with local officials to exploit an expected increase in tourism to the area this year to see the lights.

Several members of the East Peoria Community Development Foundation were on hand for Mayor Kahl's talk to Rotarians. The Foundation is in the process of raising 1.6 million dollars for the proposed "Levee Park" to be located near City Hall in the Levee District. As proposed, Levee Park would feature a water feature and space for markets and festivals in an open multipurpose lawn, as well as space for sporting and music events. "Life growing up on a dairy farm was not for the weary. Long hours of work each day bailing hay, tending to animals, etc. was normal for us. You could never take a 'day off' from the farm! That same work ethic has come in handy during my 48 years working in ministry. We can never take a 'day off' from helping those in need. This November, I will be stepping down from the role of Executive Director of Peoria Rescue Ministries. But that does not mean that the work stops! Our five divisions – Peoria Rescue Mission, Victory Acres, Barnabas Center, Women's Pregnancy Center, and Esther House – serve the homeless and those in need in our community. We also have international partner ministries that serve the people of the Ukraine (see pic) and Latvia see pic). No matter if I'm serving in an official ministry role or working on a car for someone, my goal is to introduce people to the saving grace found in Jesus Christ."
