Peoria Mayor Rita Ali and former Congressman and U.S. Transportation Secretary Ray LaHood make it clear to Rotarians on Friday. A Peoria-to-Chicago rail line will not be cheap, nor will it happen quickly. It has been two years since city leaders began looking in earnest at the re-establishment of passenger rail service between Peoria and the Windy City. Passenger service to Peoria by Amtrak ended in 1978.

Now, the Mayor and former Congressman are hoping for good news from the federal government agencies looking at initial rail proposals.

The proposed rail line would run from Peoria to LaSalle-

Peru, Ottawa, and Morris, then branching up to Joliet and Chicago. The estimated cost: 2.5 Billion dollars. But former


Transportation Secretary Lahood told Rotarians, "President Obama put eight billion (dollars) in his budget for high-

speed rail. And that's eight billion times

more than was ever put into a federal budget for rail". And, LaHood added: "Congress a year or so ago passed a trillion-dollar

transportation bill. Sixty-six billion dollars for rail, of which 24 billion will go for Amtrak." But, even with federal approval, a five-times-aday Peoria/Chicago train schedule is a long time off. Secretary LaHood put it this way: "This is going to take 10 years, these things do not happen overnight."


STERLING MERIT BANQUET COMMITTEE

Much of the world's population, especially in poor countries, is made up of children and young people. To achieve a peaceful world, it is crucial that the rights of children and young people be respected. Injustices perpetrated against children contribute to the spread of conflicts to future generations.

A 14-year-old student named Malala was shot in 2012 by the Pakistan Taliban for her advocacy for student education. Malala Yousafzai received Nobel Peace Prize in 2014 "for her struggle against the suppression of children and young people and for the right of all children to education."

In her writings and her speeches, Malala's message was: "Let's pick up our books and our pens; They are our most powerful weapons. One child, one teacher, one book and one pen can change the world."
