

Dr. Terri Goss Kinzy, ISU President Illinois State University's First Woman President

This is a warning: some 6,000 students will be moving into Illinois State University residence halls and on-campus apartments August 15-21. Plan for traffic backups and delays if you are delivering a student to campus.

ISU President Terri Goss Kinzy spoke to Peoria Rotarians on Friday,

noting that "move-in day" this year begins on August 15th and will not end until the 22nd.



ISU had to guit taking deposits for tuition early because of the number of students coming to the campus in Normal. The ISU President pointed out that those students have an average 3.62 PGA.

Goss Kinzy pointed to expansion projects on the campus, including an \$18 million building addition

to the ISU Mennonite College of Nursing for a simulation lab expected to open before the fall 2024 semester.

On the matter of tuition, the ISU President said state funding for Illinois Public Universities has been dropping, and currently provides only 14% of ISU's funding. That, she said, is less than the percentage received by other state schools. However, ISU had a private support total during last fiscal year of \$31.2 million raised.

The ISU President also invited Peoria Rotary foreign exchange student Konsta from Finland to visit the campus...offering him a chance to watch a Bradley/ISU basketball game from her private box.



Rotary Club of Peoria Youth Exchange Student

The Rotary Club of Peoria's first foreign exchange student since the 1990's made his first visit to the club on Friday. Konsta Hamalainen of Finland was introduced to members, and he in turn brought some gifts from his country: a Rotary Flag from his local club and a couple of boxes of Finnish chocolates.

Those chocolates might just be on the door prize table next week, so be sure to show up! The speaker for the day will be Angela Weck, Bradley professor and expert on Russia, who will speak about the current situation in Ukraine.
