Mike Bailey, Editor for the Peoria Magazine Peoria Magazine Updates



Mike Bailey, editor of the newly revised Peoria Magazine spent 33 years at the Peoria Journal Star... the last 13 of those as opinion page editor. Earlier this year he took over the helm of Peoria Magazine. That came after WTVP-TV President and CEO Leslie Matuszak made him an offer he couldn't refuse.

While the public TV station and the monthly magazine share ownership, Bailey says each must stand on their own feet economically. He now proudly points to the fact that his magazine has a larger circulation than his former employer.

Recently, the Chicago Sun-Times newspaper was purchased by public radio station WBEZ. It's an ownership trend Bailey sees growing. "Arguably, the current model for most traditional journalism outlets is not working," Bailey said, "and

will not work and for a variety of reasons."

Among those reasons, Bailey believes, is the failure of newspapers to recognize the power of the Internet, saying the "newspaper industry caused a lot of its own problems, they're really violating these principles, business model one."



At the end of the day, Bailey says, the responsibility of journalism remains the same as it ever was:" informing people accurately, treating people as fairly as possible. And just try to do that."

Ryan was in attendance to present a plaque from the District for achieving goals set during Janet's term as Rotary Club President in 2021-22.




