Mark Denzler is President & CEO of the Illinois Manufacturers' Association. He spoke to Peoria Rotarians last Friday. Founded in 1893, the IMA represents Illinois companies employing

650,000 women and men. These companies generate up to \$150 billion in labor income annually. In a recent editorial in Crain's Chicago Business, Denzler wrote that Illinois' government was pushing for new manufacturing jobs in the electrical vehicle market "Lawmakers are keeping their eye squarely on the ball to ensure we are competitive in this new EV arms race. Three years ago, Illinois struggled to keep up with the

competition, but today we are in nearly every discussion because of policy changes." In all, it is estimated that the manufacturing industry supports nearly 30 percent of all jobs in Illinois, making it among the state's largest industry sectors. Those companies range from CAT and Boeing to Mel-O-Cream.

The IMA won the "Manufacturing Leadership Award" in 2022 as the best manufacturing association in the U.S. The biggest challenge facing manufacturing is the worker shortage. There are currently 616,000 open manufacturing jobs nationally. To keep up with labor needs, the IMA pushed for the creation of world class manufacturing academies in Illinois. There are now two of them, in Junior Colleges at Heartland Community College Bloomington and another in Metro-East.
