Veterans Day Program with Rotary North Speaker: Retired US Army Lieutenant Colonel Harold "Hal" Fritz Topic: Medal of Honor Veteran

Retired U.S. Army Lt. Col. Harold "Hal" Fritz of Peoria is one of 49 living Medal of Honor recipients awarded for their actions in the Vietnam War.

Hal Fritz spoke at Thursday's joint Peoria Rotary Clubs' Veteran's Day Luncheon.

Fritz spoke of other Medal of Honor awardees, but characteristically, did not speak his own actions that resulted in his receiving the nation's highest military honor. Lt. Hal Fritz was seriously

wounded in a January 11th, 1969 firefight in Binh Long Province, South Vietnam during Operation Toan Thang II.

Hal Fritz's "Challenge Coin"

Despite being seriously wounded, he continued to lead his 11th Armored Cavalry platoon through the battle, even leading a counterattack. Fritz's bravery and "conspicuous gallantry" -- despite being seriously wounded-- resulted in his promotion to captain and being awarded the Medal of Honor. In his 27-year Army career, Hal Fritz also received a Silver Star, a Bronze Star, a Legion of Merit, a Purple Heart, and other service decorations.



135th Annual Santa Parade

The 135th Annual Santa Parade will be held on Friday, November 25, 2022 at 9:15am in Downtown Peoria.

The parade is the longest continuous running holiday parade in the country.

Rotary Downtown & North will again enter the Rotary Literacy float in the Santa Parade.

We will join other Rotary clubs to walk with the float this year.

The parade route travels South on Monroe, turns left onto Main St, then left on Adams, ending on Fayette.

You, your family, and friends are welcome to join us. - If you plan to walk with the float - all participants should be there by 8:30am to start lining up.

Rotary vests will be provided & they do fit over coats. Look for the large Rotary wheel on Monroe St - 1 block from the Fire Station.
