



Suzanne Ellerbrock At the Friday Rotary meeting, former District Governor Suzanne Ellerbrock, the Zone Rotary Foundation chair, spoke of how the Rotary Foundation transforms your gifts into service projects that change lives both close to home and around the world. During the past one hundred years, the Foundation has spent over three billion dollars on life-changing, sustainable projects. With your help, Rotary International can make lives better locally and around the world. It's important to know that the Rotary Foundation is

supported solely by voluntary contributions. The foundation was created in 1917 by Rotary

International's sixth president, Arch C. Klumph, as an endowment fund for Rotary "to do good in the world." It has grown from an initial contribution of US\$26.50 to more than one billion dollars.

It has one of the largest and most prestigious international fellowship programs in the world.

Rotary District 6460 Foundation

The foundation funds the anti-polio program for which Rotary has become famous. There is also funding for Disaster Recovery, Humanitarian Grants and Educational Programs. These programs have been examined for years, and the Rotary Foundation's charity score is 100-percent, a four-star rating. For Rotary year 2022-23, spendable earnings totaled \$25.8 million, of which \$20.1 million was used for program awards, \$0.6 million for operations, \$2.4 million for fund development, and \$2.6 million for general administration expenses.



Neighborhood House Santa for Seniors


