Please complete the enclosed REGISTRATION form for your essay and include it with your essay when you submit it.

Topics

- 1. It has been said that happiness is defined by financial success. Would you agree or disagree? And why you agree or disagree
- **2.** What are the biggest concerns for high school students? (guns, bullying, drugs, suicides, etc). Discuss your ideas on what is contributing to this and how you think it is and should be addressed.
- **3.** Climate change is an everyday subject. What does this mean to you? If climate change is happening, how do you think it is affecting the earth now, and how do you expect to be dealing with it 30 years from now?
- **4.** Despite the virus and other tragic thing in the news, how are you making great high school memories that you will share at your 25th Reunion?
- **5.** Do you think that there is equality in girl's sports compared to boy's sports at your school or even in general? If you see inequities how, could this be addressed?

Format

The guidelines listed below must be adhered to in the essay. A large part of the score is based on the adherence of these guidelines. Unfortunately, in previous years, excellent essays have been graded down due to non-adherence to these guidelines. Do not be one of those.

- 1. Use 8.5" by 11" paper
- 2. Use 12-point font
- Double space your essay
- 4. 1" margins on all sides of paper (top, bottom, and each side)
- Maximum length is 2 pages

- 6. Type the number of your topic choice from the list above (#1, #2, #3, #4, or # 5) in the upper left-hand corner of the first page of your essay.
- 7. Title your essay and include the title at the top center of your first page.
- 8. Important --DO NOT include your name, local Rotary, address or your high school anywhere on the essay itself. That information will be on your registration form.

The judges are the members of the Rotary District 6490 Literacy and Education Committee. The judging is completely blind without bias. The criteria for judging are guided by the State of Illinois Rubric. Essays will be scored based on Focus, Originality, Development, and Conventions (adherence to grammar, spelling, punctuation, format rules, etc.)

Entries must be received no later than March 20, 2022.

You must address and stamp an envelope to: essays are allowed to be folded.
