- The project(s) must be a new project or an enhanced project
- The project(s) must not have received an award before
- Check the Avenue of Service you are applying for each submission
- Be concise when describing your project
- Follow all rules on applications
- All applications to be filled out electronically

CLUB SERVICE AWARD focuses on making clubs strong. A thriving club is anchored by strong relationships and an active membership development plan. Clubs foster communication among club members and with the community through social media or other media coverage of club activities.

DISTRICT 6490 CRITERIA FOR ROTARY YEAR 2022-2023

VOCATIONAL SERVICE AWARD calls on every Rotarian to work with integrity and contribute their expertise to the problems and needs of society. Club members mentor young people for success in vocational pursuits, organize a vocational service discussion or group workshop to inspire others to take action, and teach other club members more about their vocation by giving a talk.

COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD encourages every Rotarian to find ways to improve the quality of life for people in their communities and to serve the public's interest. Clubs lead the planning and implementation of a sustainable local service project, secure partnerships with a corporate, governmental, or nongovernmental entity to work on a project together, and volunteer in community service projects.

INTERNATIONAL SERVICE AWARD exemplifies our global reach in promoting peace and understanding. We support this service avenue by sponsoring or volunteering on international projects, seeking partners abroad and more.

YOUTH SERVICE AWARD recognizes the importance of empowering youth and young professionals through leadership development programs. Clubs lead the planning and implementation of a service project that supports the development of young people in the community; participate in a youth exchange event; sponsor an Interact Club; or foster a connection between club members and members of a local Interact Club.

INDIVIDUAL RECOGNITION AWARDS

Rotarians who, through their Rotary service, have made the community locally and internationally a better place to live and work and have made significant contributions to Rotary and the community in the form of leadership or in the advancement of ideas and service.

SUBMISSION RULES:

- One (1) photo must accompany each nomination form
- Check the Individual Recognition you are applying for each submission
- Be concise when describing your nominee
- Follow all rules on applications
- It is appropriate to consult with Rotarians familiar with the nominee to ensure accuracy of the information
- All applications to be filled out electronically

DISTRICT 6490 CRITERIA FOR ROTARY YEAR 2022-2023

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS FOR INDIVIDUAL RECOGNITION

HALL OF HONOR AWARD: Recipient of this recognition must have been a Rotarian for at least seven (7) years in Rotary International District 6490 and must have made significant contributions to the District and his/her Club.

ROTARIAN OF THE YEAR AWARD: The recipient of this recognition must have been a Rotarian for at least three (3) years and must have demonstrated/exemplified, to the highest degree, the ideals of Rotary service during the current Rotary year.

NEW ROTARIAN OF THE YEAR: The recipient of this recognition shall be a new Rotarian who joined a Rotary Club in Rotary International District 6490 at such time that he/she shall have completed at least twelve (12) months but not more than thirty-six (36) months membership at the time he/she is nominated.

DISTRICT 6490 CRITERIA FOR ROTARY YEAR 2022-2023

CLUB OF THE YEAR AWARD

Recognizes the Club that has performed in the highest traditions of Rotary during the previous year. The Outstanding Rotary Club of the Year will demonstrate high achievement as an effective Rotary Club.

AWARD

The District 6490 Outstanding Rotary Club of the Year Award (Large or Small Club) is a large cloth banner that the Club may display for one year. The banner typically has the Rotary wheel and the words "District 6490 Rotary Club of the Year," the name of the Club, the name of the Club President and year of presentation. The award will be presented at the annual District 6490 Conference (September 8-9).

NOMINATIONS

Each member may nominate one (1) Rotary Club.

SELECTION

The District Governor and members of the District Awards Committee will be the Selection Committee.

DISTRICT 6490 CRITERIA FOR ROTARY YEAR 2022-2023

SELECTION CRITERIA

MAIN CRITERIA

1. ALL Clubs nominated should qualify for the RI Presidential Citation
2. ALL Clubs should show a net increase in club membership (excluding Honorary members) between July 1 thru June 30 of the current Rotary year
3. Membership increase may include those who have been approved for membership by the Club before the year end, but may not have been formally inducted or added to the RI database

OPTIONAL CRITERIA

The following may be considered:

MEMBERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

- Specific membership development programs undertaken by the Club in the current Rotary year
- New member orientation, mentoring, and member education initiatives developed by the Club
- Sponsorship of a new Rotary, Interact, Rotaract or Satellite Club
- Public Relations programs undertaken by the Club in the current Rotary year

DISTRICT 6490 CRITERIA FOR ROTARY YEAR 2022-2023

SERVICE PROJECTS

- Current local service project(s)
- Current world community service project(s)
- Level of hands on Club involvement in service projects rather than the dollar value should be considered the primary factor
- Sponsorship of Youth Exchange services
- Active involvement with an Interact and/or Rotaract Club(s)
- Sponsorship of candidates to RYLA and other Rotary sponsored youth programs

THE ROTARY FOUNDATION

- Club members service on District, Zone, or RI committees or task forces
- Club attendance at District training seminars and other District events
- Club registrations for the upcoming RI Convention and/or the District Conference

NOMINATION FORMS
