We recommend that clubs charge \$50 to the participants to make sure they understand how important it is that they indeed attend camp.



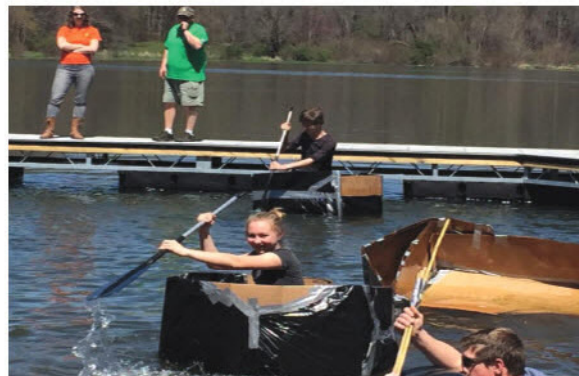
