

**ROTARY CLUB OF DECATUR #180
GRANT GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION PROCESS**

The Rotary Club of Decatur is a not-for-profit organization dedicated to serving the greater Decatur area. The Rotary Club maintains a grants program that is designed to support activities and programs that will have a beneficial impact on the community and improve the quality of life in the Decatur area.

Specifically, the Rotary Club of Decatur appropriates grant funding for the following:

- **Programs and Activities which benefit youth:** The Rotary Club will support programs and activities that have a positive impact on youth. These programs and/or activities must result in new learning and new experiences for youth that will enable them to make constructive contributions to their communities and their peers. Such programs should introduce youth to activities and programs which are beyond normal schooling, and which enhance the ability of our youth to become leaders, contributors, and possibly future Rotarians.

- **Programs and Activities which expose youth and adults to different cultures, customs, and languages:** Rotary is an international business and professional service organization, and as such, Rotary supports activities of a multicultural and international theme that introduce individuals of various cultures to different practices and customs both in the business world and in daily living. As such, programs which encourage the introduction of different cultures and customs and improve alliances and partnerships with other people and nations are eligible for funding through the Rotary Club of Decatur Grants Program.

Grant Applications are accepted from October 1 – November 30, 2021. *The activity must take place during the calendar year of January 1 to December 31 in the year following the application process.*

All Grant Applications must include a budget for the proposed project, activity, or program.

Grant Applications must include proof of the applicant's 501(c)(3) status.

Final Reports must be submitted 30 days following completion of the project, activity or program.
