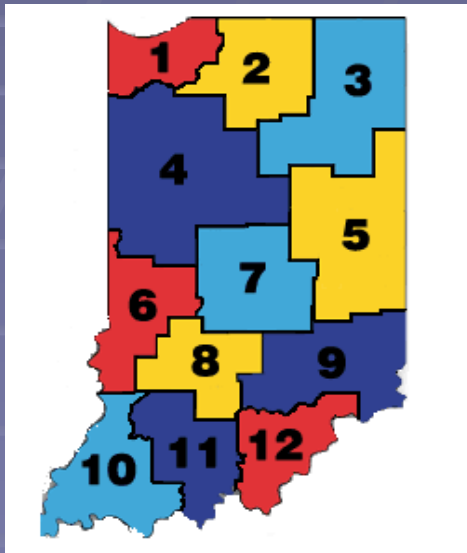

Greater Lafayette Cultural Plan – An Overview



What is cultural planning?

- Community planning with arts & cultural “lens”
- Engage entire community *and* cultural sector
- Focus on interests, needs, priorities
- To make better use of existing, limited civic resources
- GOAL: Serve culture, serve community



Why cultural planning?

Use arts and culture to strengthen our community (e.g., downtown, schools, etc.)

Strong support from civic leaders, understand value of creative economy

Scarce resources – important time to plan

Build/maintain Greater Lafayette's position.



How did this project begin?

2005

Established task force to assess current state of the arts, recommended a comprehensive cultural plan for the community.

2006

“Plan to Plan” group established with cultural groups – approved process with TAF as commissioning organization. Co-chairs/Steering Committee named.



- 2007
Steering Committee assessed need, circulated RFP, selected consultants.
- 2008
Contract signed with WolfBrown, Steering Committee expanded and planning process launched.

Sustain Lafayette/West Lafayette's cultural ecology through stronger leadership and resource development.



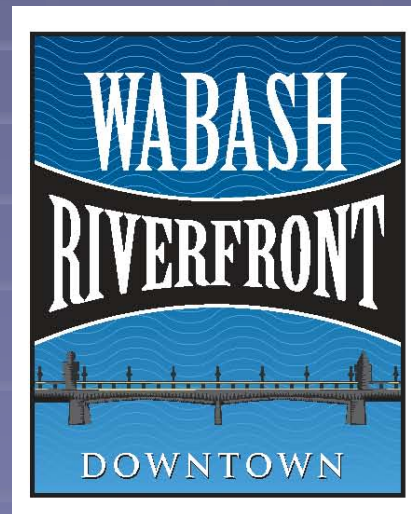
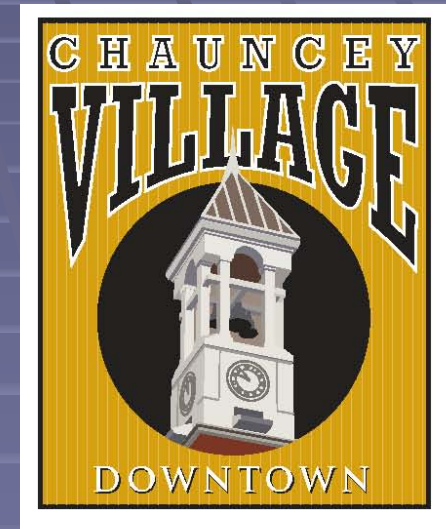
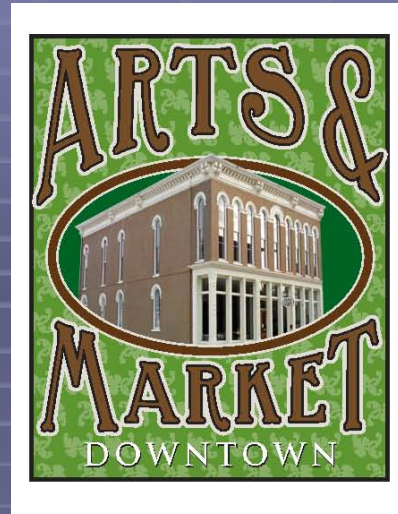
