- **4. Complete a one-to-two page essay** about yourself and your family, explaining your reason for attending college, need for the scholarship, and your future plans.
- 5. Arrange for two (2) letters of recommendation to be sent by March 14, 2014 via PDF directly to rotary.lafayette.scholarship@gmail.com or by mail to Patti Truitt, P.O. Box 711, Lafayette, IN 47902 (PDF transmission preferred). At least one recommendation must be from a faculty member. The other may be from an individual such as a faculty member, administrator, advisor, counselor, or employer. Please give recommenders the attached Guidelines for Scholarship Recommendations.
- **6.** Submit a copy of your current transcript electronically via PDF by Friday, March 14, 2014 via PDF to the email address below; unofficial copies are acceptable.
- 7. Six \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded for academic expenses including tuition, books or required course expenses. Funds will be disbursed directly to the college. Recipients will be notified on or about April 15, 2014 and will be honored at the Rotary Club lunch meeting on May 20, 2014.
