The Four-Way Test of the things we think, say or do:

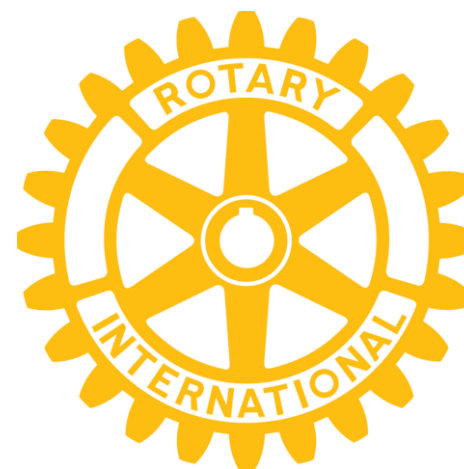
**First**—Is it the TRUTH?
