Things to know about Madina Village School in 2020:

*400+ students are working hard daily from 7:45-2:30 (Upper classes stay until 4:00 p.m.). Attendance is strong, morale is high, teachers are dedicated. No covid!

*Meanwhile, **our school nurse makes house calls.** This year’s malaria prevention program is under way, with new bed nets for all our new preschoolers (plus locally made mattresses to go with the bed nets for those who Nurse Marian finds are sleeping on the floor.) Notice that last phrase of our mission statement ... “and to improve their quality of life through outreach”.

Thanks to all donors who have cared enough to make this happen!

*There are 167 children sponsored for \$30/month. You who are sponsors have been so faithful during this pandemic. We are grateful. Spread the word for more. Every child would love to have a sponsor.

* Doors and windows of the new health center/hospital are paid for (YAY) and are being installed in December. As soon as doors and windows are all in to secure the building, our S.O.S. partners will start getting the equipment and furniture ready to ship. They are a huge answer to prayer!

*Our goal is to have the health center completed by summer 2021. We are still raising funds for solar power and plumbing, sinks and toilets and floor tiles and ceilings. If you have been asking 'how can I help?' those are the homely details!

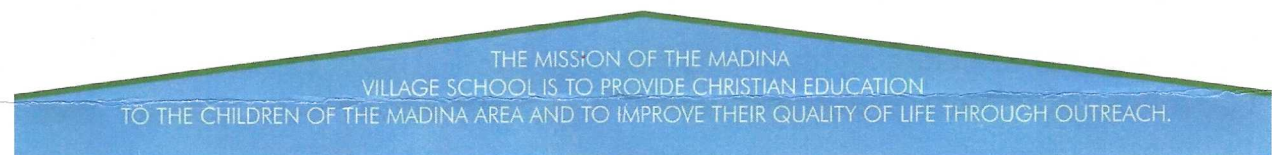
