The Polio Plus program is the organization's top philanthropic priority. Since 1985, Rotary has worked with GPEI to help immunize more than 2 billion children and reduced the number of polio cases by 99%.

In taking up polio eradication as its first corporate project in 1985, Rotary embarked on an ambitious fundraising campaign. By the time the world is certified polio-free, Rotary's contributions to the global effort will exceed \$1.2 billion.
