Linda started with a Day 100 for Paul Harris (two gainfully employed children). Walt Hibner gave a Day 100 (back from Houston International Rotary & Junior Diabetes Research Foundation 100+ mile bike ride in Michigan). Steve Conklin gave a Day 10 to ask the group for any referrals as he is between positions at the moment. Kim Pollard gave a Day 10 for the Strong Jamb going into mass and bringing jobs to the community. Jean Maychack gave a Day-50 for her 4th grandchild being baptized on Sunday and a wonderful family.

President Shaun then came back to the podium and thanked Iris and others for putting together the gala with only two more meetings left in his term and 18 days left in the fiscal Rotary year. He asked that each consider a gift of any amount to the Rotary International Foundation and reminded the group about visiting the Cincinnati Rotary Club on June 23rd if anyone wants to tag along. Shaun then called on Nicole Sturk as Chair of the Day. Nicole Sturk introduced our speaker for the day, Molly Brunk, Director of the Be Hope Immigration Center. The center opened in the summer of 2021. So far they have served more than 90 clients to date, with a goal of 220 clients by June, 2023. They offer low-cost legal assistance. The Department of Justice offers training so that Molly and others can help refugees navigate the immigration legal center. They do not represent clients in court, but rather help navigate the legal system and paperwork.

They offer a Entrepreneurship class which teaches financial literacy and facilitates pursuing business start-ups. They assist with citizenship exam preparation, employment authorization, green cards, DACA (parents didn't have citizenship), family petitions, etc. and have helped 6 clients gain citizenship. They can only serve the mission if they have enough certified representative and they welcome volunteers.

Our next meeting will be on June 20<sup>th</sup> and will be held at Sinclair Community College, and available via Zoom as well.
