COMMUNITY SERVICE – Corey Watt –

1. Jonathan, Kathy Butterfield, Heidi Schiller and Corey met with Tyler Moore from Volt Media to discuss the possibility of creating a video focusing on Stars and Stripes and Oxford Rotary. The sub-committee received an estimate of \$2,400 to create a video. The board approved paying Volt Media Production \$1,200 to begin the project. - 2. The committee would like to support RYLA by taking on two students possibly more. We are looking for ways to improve the nomination process.
