Youth will participate in learning activities and experiences that help students and participants to understand and ask questions on Peace, Peacebuilding, Leadership and Conflict Resolution Skills. All our programs and workshops are fun, hands-on and interactive - we believe in challenging and inspiring every individual to develop the will and the skill to help achieve a more peaceful, collaborative and sustainable community and world.

Experiential peacebuilding (ExPB) integrates peacebuilding theory and skills with the power of experiential learning—that is, learning by doing and reflecting. It is best thought of as an active process with transformative power.

Some of the topics we will cover include:

- What do we mean by Peace and Peacebuilding?
- What is the relationship between Peace and Conflict?
- What is my leadership style? What is my conflict style?
- Positive Peace & Negative Peace
- The Eight Pillars of Positive Peace and the idea of Interdependence
- What is the relationship between the natural environment, human communities and peace?

We will engage with the works of leading peacebuilding thinkers like Johann Galtung and the work of the Institute for Economics and Peace (IEP) and the Global Peace Index.

Participants will work in small groups, pairs and individually in a series of interactive activities, and all participants will have a chance to shape the content of the day and ask any and all questions.
