

HUMAN TRAFFICKING IN OHIO

KEY CHARACTERISTICS OF IDENTIFIED HUMAN TRAFFICKING VICTIMS

- The majority of victims were white (57.6%). More than a third were black (35.4%), while 6.4% were multi-racial. 92% identified as non-Hispanic/Latino.
- The majority of victims were identified in higher population, urban counties (80%).
- Sex trafficking (86.8%) is far more prevalent than labor trafficking.
- The majority of victims were minors (85.5%).
- The majority of victims were female (82.6%).
