4. A list of all other funding sources and partnering organizations.
5. Identification of ongoing ways that Rotary can support the project (e.g., service opportunities for the Tri-Village Rotary).

Tri-Village Rotary does not typically fund:

- Travel expenses.
- Meal reimbursements.
- Grant writing fees.
- Compensation of employees.

Your grant is more likely to be approved if:

- Your application is completely filled out (see steps 1-5 above).
- You have considered multiple sources of funding.
- Your project promotes and is aligned to our Mission Statement.
