Many of you have watched the DG video and know that our Rotary International (RI) President is Ian Riseley from Australia and his theme is Rotary: Making a Difference.

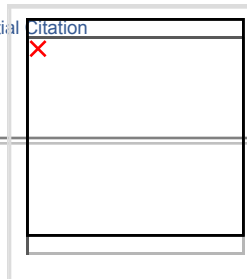

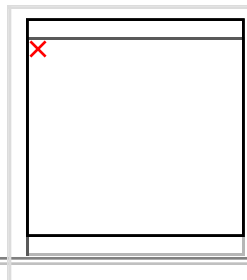
RYLA; Rotary – Building Tomorrow's Leaders Today
