FG Rotary Member Connection Program Guidelines

Purpose:

To acknowledge and recognize events in Club member's lives to foster the philosophy of what it means to be a Rotarian.

Communication:

Club members may bring events to be recognized to the attention of the Club Member Connection Representative (MC Rep) who will disseminate the information to club members via email (through the Social Media Chair) or general announcement. The MC Rep will work with the initiating Club Member to determine as much detailed information as possible such as funeral arrangements, preferences of family, hospital stay, etc. If necessary the MC Rep may reach out to the parties' involved to ascertain further information appropriate for dissemination to the Club.

Scope:

The following events fall within the scope of the Member Connection Program:

- 1. Sympathy Cards for Member: Spouse, Parent, Children or Member family
- 2. Get Well Card: Determined at the discretion of the Club Member requesting and the MC Rep. May be limited to prolonged illness or hospitalization.
- 3. Special Occasion Cards as requested by the Club Member: Determined at the discretion of the Club Member requesting and the MC Rep. Examples may be a wedding or recognition for a major achievement.
- 4. Flowers: There may be times when the Club Member and MC Rep determine that the event warrants flowers. The MC Rep will communicate the circumstances to the Administration Chair who will request a special stand-up board meeting for approval of the finances.

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
