Key item to consider is that many Long Term Care Insurance plans don't begin paying until 60, 90, or more days of service have been paid for. Only then doesn't the policy begin coverage. Unless this is considered, and full time care is suddenly needed, it may be time consuming and very expensive in out of pocket costs until the policy begins paying. Her organization provides in home care as needed as well as an adult day care center which can be a good transition step.
