LINE UP: Beginning at White County High School, at Noon

FLOATS: In order to be judged, entries must be decorated and lined up at 1:00 PM. Floats must not exceed 30 feet in length, and are required to have reflectors on the rear of the float and trailer for visibility. Any floats or trailers that do not have reflectors will be disqualified. Please have your insurance declaration page visible at lineup. If you leave your vehicle at WCHS, please park in the upper parking lot off of Robert Knight Drive.

WEATHER: Should the weather create hazardous road conditions, the Parade Committee will decide whether to move forward with the Parade as soon as such a decision can be reliably made. This Parade has previously proceeded in rain and light snow. If, on the day of the Parade, the weather creates hazardous road conditions, the Parade committee will determine whether to move forward with the Parade. Each person, and/or parent if a minor child is involved or riding on the float/trailer, must determine whether to participate in the parade at his or her own risk. **If the Parade is canceled, it will not be rescheduled**, but float judging will occur at a to-be-determined time & place.

PRIZES: 1st Place \$300, 2nd Place \$200, and 3rd Place \$100

HORSES: Horses will group at the North end of Allen Drive on Roosevelt Drive to join lineup after Santa's float. If possible, horse trailers can be staged on the east side of town to alleviate the need for horse riders to travel back across town after dark. If you MUST ride the horses back across town, please take every precaution and have reflectors on animal and clothing to avoid any potential problems.

FIRE TRUCKS: Fire trucks will group in the old Food Lion parking lot. Please use caution when using your sirens – sirens are loud, and may drown out the groups in front of you.

TRACTORS: Tractors may lineup in front of the Vocational School parking area. Please have your insurance declaration page visible at lineup.

MOTORCYCLES: Clubs may enter only as a group. Please have your insurance declaration page visible at lineup.

OTHER ENTRIES: All vehicles must be street legal, operated by a licensed driver, and insured. Please have your insurance declaration page visible at lineup. Pedestrians may enter only as a group. Skateboards, roller skates, hoverboards, etc. are not allowed.

ROUTE: Allen Drive, turn right on Polk, left on Hampton, left on Bockman Way, right onto Liberty Square at Courthouse, left on Maple Street. Try to stay close to entry in front of you.

DISASSEMBLE: Please, Do Not Stop on The Square.

If your unit will be stopping to let children or other people off, proceed to the end of Maple Street to park and let your passengers off to walk back to the Square. Otherwise you should turn down South Young Street and go back to the High School by way of Hwy 111. You can park on the street until the activity on the Square is over. If you are picking up children you may park in the Citizens Bank Parking lot, First Christian Church parking lot, and either of the City parking lots and walk to their unit on Maple Street.
