Art entries are original works in the following categories: Painting, Drawing, Sculpture, Ceramics, Digital Photography, Traditional Photography, Computer Graphics, Mixed-Media, and Printmaking.

The Rotary Club of Oak Ridge Sunset, Consolidated Nuclear Security LLC and other sponsors of this event aim to engage and excite students to the wonders and adventures of science; to motivate life-long science learners and investigators; and expose students to science career opportunities!
