- Required to have an audit of grants performed. This was performed by Bill Harwell, District Grants Auditor, who completed this audit reviewing (in following prior year RI instructions): details and support data for the 6 randomly selected grants, monthly bank statements, and all other data. Referring to the instructions, performed all requirements and provided good report.
- Available DDF by District for DG Carol's year (Foundation handout 1)
 - Started year with \$426,226.93
 - o Spent:
 - Transferred funds for 2 grants for Polio Plus, 1 grant for Rotary Center for International Studies
 - 4 grants we have already transferred funds to these grants: District Block
 Grant for District Grants, Family Health Days (assist Larry Lunsford), Mexico
 Peace Conference, and Heath Johnson Scholarship
 - 2 others have been tagged, including: Sam Owori project and Sri Lanka Cervical Cancer Project.
 - 3 other projects tagged/committed funds (not showing on report) Shades Valley Club \$24,750, Dicky Gray Project \$2500, Dialysis Center in India (RIPE Mark Maloney request) \$8000.
 - Currently have remaining \$29,000 untagged and unspent DDF still in our account at Rotary International. Disposition of these funds is currently in discussion.
- District Grants Overview (Foundation handout 2)
 - \$116,837 Block Grant
 - o 31 Clubs have given 42 different grants
 - Available to each Club was a maximum amount of \$4000
- Detail for 42 grants (Foundation handout 3)

• If Club wants to participate in a grant next year (application and/or in process), a representative must attend grant training seminar May 4 in Gardendale or May 18 in Decatur area. Otherwise, must wait for following year.
