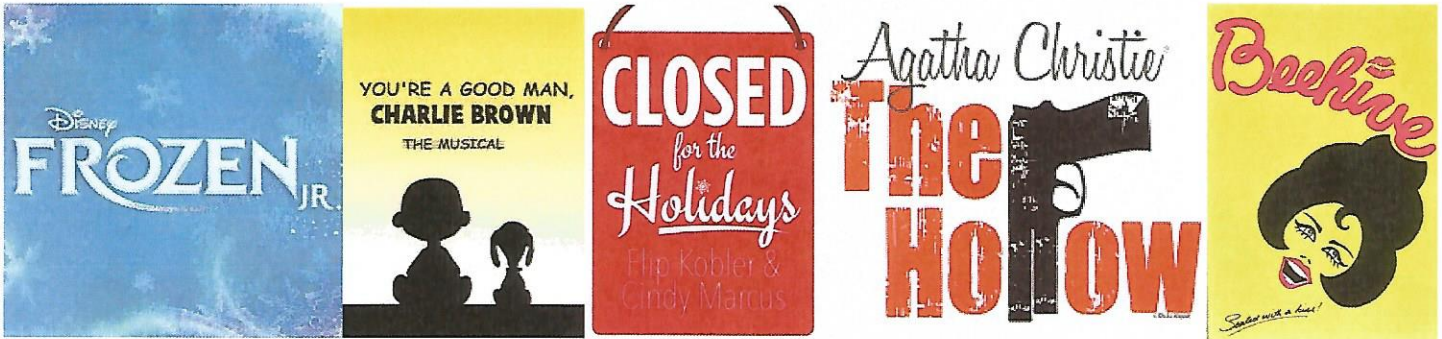
And be on the lookout for announcements concerning our ***11th Annual Performing Arts Camp*** with Julia Langley for ages 6 - 16.
